HAVE GRANTED, conveyed and released, and by these Presents, DO GRANT, convey, and release unto the said

Louise Greer and John Henry Greer

All that certain lot of land situate, lying and being near the southern limits of the Town of Greer, Chick Springs Township, County and State aforesaid, and known and designated as Lot #1, and shown on Plat of property of the I. M. Wood Estate made by H. S. Brockman, Surveyor, on March 19, 1946, and of record in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Plat Book "P", Page 33, and having the following metes and bounds and courses and distances as shown by said plat, to-wit:

BEGINNING at a point at the southeastern intersection of Pelham and Palmer Streets and running thence along the line of Palmer Street S. 68-23 E. 150 feet to an Iron pin; thence S. 33-30 W. 57.2 feet to iron pin at corner of lot #2; thence along the line of Lot #2 N. 68-23 W. 150 feet to an iron pin in the eastern line in Pelham Street; thence along the line of Pelham Street N. 33-30 E. 57.2 feet to the point of beginning.

The grantees are to pay all taxes on the above property beginning with the year 1946.
