All that certain piece, parcel or tract of land situate, lying and being in Dunklin Township, County and State aforesaid, and in 1-E School District, and being known and designated as tract "D" according to a plat of said property made by Pickell & Pickell, Engineers, on March 28, 1945, said tract containing 16 acres, more or less, and having the following courses and distances, to-wit:

BEGINNING at a stake, the same being the southwest corner of tract "D", according to said plat, and running thence S. 66.45 E. 2400 feet to a stake; thence N. 11.40 E. 300 feet, joint corner of tracts "C" and "D"; thence along joint line of tracts "C" and "D", N. 66.45 W. 2380 feet, joint corner of tracts "C" and "D"; thence S. 13.30 E. 300 feet to the beginning corner.
