BEGINNING at a stone corner of the W. A. Hudson Estate, and runs thence
S. $40\frac{1}{4}$ E. 10.75 chains to a stone; thence S. 8 W. 6.96 chains to a black locust; thence S.
 $84\frac{1}{2}$ W. 5.09 chains to a persimmon tree; thence N. $27\frac{1}{2}$ W. 4.73 to a stone on the south side of
road; thence N. 48 W. 7.93 chains to a stone; thence N. 9.28 chains to the beginning corner,
containing $12\frac{1}{2}$ acres according to a plat made by E. F. Neves, November 22nd, 1915, recorded
