The certain tract of land lying, being and situated in Greenville County, South Carolina, on branch waters of Vaughn's Creek, waters of North Pacolet river, beginning on dogwood (cut down) now on stone and runs North 70 W. 22.38 chains to dogwood marked 3X; thence south 37½ W. 21.80 ch. to stone marked 3X; thence south 63½ E. 22 ch. to stone marked 3X; thence N. 37½ E. 24.50 24.50 ch. to the Beginning, corner, containing fifty acres, more or less, except six acres belonging to Mrs. T. P. Watson, conveyed to her by the heirs of Merdith Morgan.

Also, the certain tract or parcel of land situate in the County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, lying on both sides of branch, waters of Vaughn's Creek, said waters of N. Pacolet River, adjoining lands of Merdith Morgan and Decuth May Carruth and Theron Earle, and beginning at a hickory, old corner and running thence S. 79½ E. 5 chains to a deed chestnut; thence S. 4 E. 21½ ch. to a stake in the road (oak grove); thence along said road to the original line near rock; thence S. 71½ W. 15 chains to a pine above red oak on A. D. Bowers' corner; thence S. 21½ W. 80 links to a stone; thence N. 63½ W. 17 ch. to a stake; thence N. 37½ E. 24½ ch. to a rock; thence N. 12 E. crossing Vaughn's Creek 11.8 chains to the beginning corner, containing fifty acres, more or less.
