WHEREAS by deed dated April 17, 1946 Maggie Mae Thrift Lampe by her attorney in fact, Julian E. Harmon conveyed certain property on Hammett Street in Greenville County to Silda Hargrove, deed recorded in R.M.C. Office for Greenville County in Volume 293, page 209, and WHEREAS, all of lot 5, same fronting 100 feet on Hammett Street was conveyed in said deed and whereas it was the intention of the grantor in said deed to convey only fifty feet of said lot No. 5, and whereas Silda Hargrove desires to correct said deed to her by re-conveying to Maggie Mae Thrift Lampe that portion of Lot 5 not intended to be included in said deed to Silda Hargrove, now, therefore,

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That I, Silda Hargrove

in the State aforesaid

in consideration of the sum of five

DOLLARS

to me in hand paid, at and before the sealing of these presents by Maggie Mae Thrift Lampe

in the State aforesaid, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release, unto the said Maggie Mae Thrift Lampe

All that piece, parcel or lot of land in Greenville Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, about 1 1/4 miles from Greenville Courthouse and north of Poe Mill, on the North side of Hammett Street, being part of Lot No. 5 of Hammett lands according to plat recorded in R.M. C. Office for Greenville County in deed book HHH, page 835, and having according to said plat the following metes and bounds:

Beginning at a point on the north side of Hammett Street at the joint front corner of lots 4 and 5, running thence along the line of lot 4 N. 21 1/2 E. 190 feet to a point on an alley; thence along said alley S. 68 1/2 E. 50 feet to a point in the center of the rear line of lot 5 thence along the center of lot 5, S. 21 1/2 W. 190 feet to a point on the north side of Hammett Street; thence along the north side of Hammett Street N. 68 1/2 W. 50 feet to beginning.
