on the Old Camp Road, leading from Greenville to Paris Station and having according to a survey and plat made by R. E. Dalton, Engineer, February 1921, the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pipe on the South side of the highway and thence with line of Stone property S. 16-15 E. 335 feet to an iron pipe; thence S. 31-30 E. 276 feet to an iron pipe on the west of Summitt Drive; thence S. 31-30 East 15.9 feet to the center of Summitt Drive; thence S. 42-34 W. 90 feet to a point in the center of Summitt Drive; thence with the North line of Mildred T. Suddeth N. 89.0 W. 609 feet to an iron pin; thence S. 10 E. 57 feet to an iron pin; thence S. 86-10 W. 180 feet to an iron pipe the Northeast corner of Tract No. 3; thence with the E. line of Tract No. 3 N. 19-07 W. 467 feet to a pipe on the South side of Camp Road; thence with the South side of Camp Road N. 70-44 E. 247.4 feet to a corner; thence with the South side of Camp Road N. 73-05 E. 231.9 to a new corner; thence S. 16-30 E. 300 feet to a new corner; thence N. 73-05 East 125 feet to a new corner; thence N. 16-30 W. 300 feet to a stake on the South side of the Old Camp Road; thence N. 73.45 E. with the South side of Camp Road 190.7 feet to the beginning corner.
