EIGHTH: That subsequently there was elected as President J. E. Bentley as Vice-President; as Secretary, John A. Carson

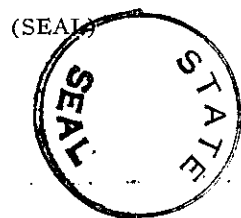
