Beginning at an iron pin in the center of above described road and runs thence N. 86-00 W 426 feet to iron pin; thence S. 0-30 W. 211 feet to an iron pin; thence S. 86-00 E. 405 feet to iron pin in the center of said State Highway No. 14; thence with the said State Highway No. 14 N. 6-15 E. 209.8 feet to the beginning corner, containing two acres, more or less.
