in the State aforesaid, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release, unto the said Claude W. Cartar, all of our undivided two-thirds interest in and to that certain place, parcel or tract of land situate, lying and being in Butler Township, County and State aforesaid, and having the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at corner of J. W. Rector land, thence N. 7-30 E. 245 feet to iron pin; thence S. 59-05 W. 935 feet to iron pin; thence S. 2-30 W. 51.5 feet to iron pin; thence East 423 feet to iron pin; thence N. 9 W. 231 feet to an iron pin; thence N. 81 E. 398 feet to the beginning corner, containing two and 91/100 (2.91) acres more or less and being a portion of the M.
