(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged) have granted, bargained, sold, and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said

Florida A. Hudson, her heirs and assigns, forever;

All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land situate, lying and being on the West side of the road leading from the Greenville Pelham Road to the Roper Mountain Road, in Butler Township, Greenville County, South Carolina, containing 8.60 acres, according to survey made by H. S. Brockman, Surveyor, August 30, 1941 and having the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at a stake on the West side of the road leading South from the Greenville-Pelham Road toward the Roper Mountain Road at corner of lands of Floride A Hudson and running thence with said Hudson line, S. 56-30 W. 1320 feet to an iron pin; thence with the line of property now or formerly of W. H. Smith, S. 75-00 E. 782 feet, more or less, to an iron pin in the center of the road leading from Greenville-Pelham Road to Roper Mountain Road; thence with the center of said road in a generally Northeasterly direction 980 feet, more or less, to the beginning corner.

This is a portion of that lot of land conveyed to the Grantor by deed of B.E. Greer, dated September 13, 1945, recorded in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County in Deed Book 280, Page 169.

The Grantee is to pay 1947 taxes.
