Adjoining the lands of John A. Ward, J. M. Pace and others. Being the land conveyed to J. H. Pace and his wife A. O. Pace, by P. T. Ward and his wife Jane Ward.

FIRST, That he is the owner and lawfully seized of said premises. SECOND, That he has a good right to convey the same. THIRD, That the same are free from all encumbrances whatever. And FOURTH, That the said parties of the second part, their heirs and assigns, shall quietly enjoy and possess the same and that he will Warrant and Defend the Title to the same against all lawful claims.
