KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That We, Lora M. Davis, Joseph E. Davis and Sarah Davis Bishop,

in the State aforesaid in consideration of the sum of Five Hundred Seventy-five (\$575.00) DOLLARS

to us in hand paid, at and before the sealing of these presents by A. B. Cannon

in the State aforesaid, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release, unto the said A. B. Cannon and his heirs and assigns forever:

all that piece, parcel or lot of land in Highland Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, at the Lenoah Public School, lying on the South side of of surfaced road leading from the School by Camp Creek to Tigerville, being all of tract No. 17 on a plat of property made for the W. W. Davis Estate by H. L. Dunahoo, Surveyor, dated January 23, 1947, having the following courses and distances: BEGINNING on a stake on the South edge of said road, joint corner with Jenkins, and runs thence with Jenkins' line S. 18.00 W. 752 feet to an iron pin; thence with Jenkins' line N. 42.00 W. 401 feet to a stake; thence N. 53.50 W. 228 feet to a poplar corner of tract No. 16; thence N. 25.45 E. 485 feet to a stake on the South edge of said road; thence with the southern edge of said road 500 feet to the beginning corner, containing Seven and three-tenths (7.3) Acres, more or less.
