in the State aforesaid, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release, unto the said Carl L. Belcher and his heirs and assigns forever:

all that piece, parcel or lot of land in Highland Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, lying on the West side of the paved road that leads from Oneal by Lenoah School to Highland, lying just North from said School, being all of lot No. 4 on a plat of property made for the W. W. Davis Estate by H. L. Dunahoo, Surveyor, dated January 23, 1947, and having the following courses and distances:

BEGINNING on a stake on the West edge of said road, joint corner of lots Nos. 3 and 4, and runs thence with the line of lot No. 3 N. 88.30 W. 300 feet to a stake, joint corner of lots Nos. 3, 4, 10 and 11; thence S. 1.30 W. 200 feet to a stake, corner of lot No. 5; thence with the line of lot No. 5 S. 88.30 E. 300 feet to a stake on the West edge of said road; thence with West edge of said road N. 1.30 E. 200 feet to the beginning corner.
