Beginning at an iron pin on the south side of Goodrich Street at a point forty-two and two-tenths (42.2) feet southeast from the northwest corner of Lot No. sixty-five (65), and running thence through the center of lot No. sixty-five (65) S. 36-15 W. one hundred sixteen and eight-tenths (116.8) feet, more or less, to an iron pin in line of Lot No. 64; thence with line of lots Nos. 64 and 63, S. 59-23 E. fifty-seven and fifty-five (57.55) one-hundredths feet to an iron pin in rear line of Lot No. 66; thence in a northeasterly direction through Lot No. 66 one hundred and twenty-two (122) feet, more or less, to an iron pin on the south side of Goodrich Street; thence along the south side of Goodrich Street N. 64-49 W. fifty-eight and six-tenths (58.6) feet to the beginning corner.
