All that parcel, piece or lot of land, with the buildings and improvements thereon, situate, ly-
ing and being near the City of Greenville, in the County of Greenville, State of South Carolina,
located on the South side of Cureton Street, and being a portion of Block K of Kanatenah, a plat
of which is recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County, in Plat Book F, at page 131,
and having, according to a plat of the property of Ann^b Turner Lindsey, made by Dalton & Neves,
Engineers, March, 1946, the following metes and bounds, courses and distances, to-wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the South side of Cureton Street, 145' in an Easterly direction
from the point where Mitchell Street intersects with Cureton Street, the Northeast corner of the
G. R. Bodie lot (which point is also 65-ft. East of the Annie Wood Lawton lot), and running
thence along the Bodie lot, S. 24-42 E. 178.7 ft. to an iron pin; thence N. 64-40 E. 65 ft. to
an iron pin; thence N. 24-42 W. 178.7 feet to an iron pin in the line of Cureton Street; thence
along the Southern side of Cureton Street, S. 64-40 W. 65 ft. to the point of beginning.
