All that certain piece, parcel and lot of land situate lying and being in the State and County aforesaid, Highland Township, and being a portion of the same land conveyed to me by deed from J. D. Crain, Dec. 1st, 1916, said deed recorded in the office of the R. M. C. of said County in Vol. 38 at page 281; and having the following metes and bounds, courses and distances: Beginning at a stone near a large pine stump and running thence N. 58½ W. 5.35 chs. to a stake in a settlement road; thence with the said road as the line S. 65½ E. 3.52 chs. to a bend in road; thence S. 76½ E. 1.84 chs. to an iron pin in center of said settlement road; thence S. 30 W. 1.02 chs. to the beginning corner, containing twenty-one one-hundredths (21/100) acres, more or less.
