W. C. Armstrong, his heirs and assigns forever:

All that piece, parcel or lot of land in Dunklin Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina.

lying and situate on the Dunklin Bridge Road, containing One Hundred and Eleven (111) acres, more or less, bounded by lands now owned by or formerly belonging to Mrs. Emma Sullivan, Belton Sims, Hortense Abercrombie, and William Sims (deceased), and being the same tract of land that was devised to William Sims by Elizabeth Sims by her last will and Testament, being known as the William Sims Home Place, and being a tract of 205 acres, less 94 acres conveyed to Hortense Abercrombie by deed recorded in Deed Book 54 at page 288, R. M. C. Office for Greenville County; and being the same tract of land conveyed to Belton Sims, Sr., by E.
