

DEED TO RIGHT-OF-WAY

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That I (or we) Claire Smith Lucius

in consideration of the sum of \$1.00, to me (or us) in hand paid, and other valuable consideration at and before sealing and delivering hereof, by the City of Greenville, South Carolina, receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold, and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell, and release unto the said City of Greenville, South Carolina, its successors and assigns, a right-of-way for the construction of a section of the street on College Street

in the City of Greenville, State and County aforesaid, for the purpose of locating, constructing, improving, and maintaining the above described street. Bounded

by lands of _____

Described as follows:

Beginning at a point on the southern side of College Street, the joint corner of Lucius and Russell; thence along the southern side of College Street in a westerly direction 60 feet to a point, the joint corner of Lucius and Hellams; thence in a southerly direction along the Lucius-Hellams property line 1.6 feet more or less to a point; thence in an easterly direction 60.1 feet more or less on the Lucius-Russell property line; thence along the Lucius-Russell property line in a northerly direction 2.7 feet to the beginning point.

The above described property to be used for street purposes.

"Special Provisions:"

The Grantee agrees, if it should pay any other property owners by agreement for vacant strips of land on College Street, that it will pay the Grantor in the same proportion, for the land herein described, this, however, does not apply to awards through condemnation or court proceedings or special damages to buildings, tenants, et cetera. This instrument embodies the entire agreement for the within right-of-way.

The Grantee also agrees to replace or to rebuild in a proper manner all damaged walks, driveways, curbs, walls, fences and piers now on said property.
