All that tract or parcel of land lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, on the north side of College Street in the City of Greenville and being more particularly described according to plat prepared by Dalton and Neves, Engineers, dated August, 1946, and having the following metes and bounds, to-wit:
