All that piece, parcel or lot of land in O'Neal Township, Greenville County, State

of South Carolina, about four (4) miles Northwest of the City of Greer, in Washington School District, and bounded on the east by the Greer-Gowensville Highway, on the south by lands of Egbert Mostillar and on the west by lands of Ray, and on the north by lands of Tandy Pull and containing fifty (50) acres, more or less, and more fully shown by plat prepared by H. S. Frockman in 1946, and known formerly as the James Howell home-
stead, and the same tract of which Furman Dill died seized and possessed.

(It is the intention of the grantors herein to include by this conveyance any and all right of inheritance, contingent or otherwise, which might in the future ripen into vested rights under the will of T. F.
