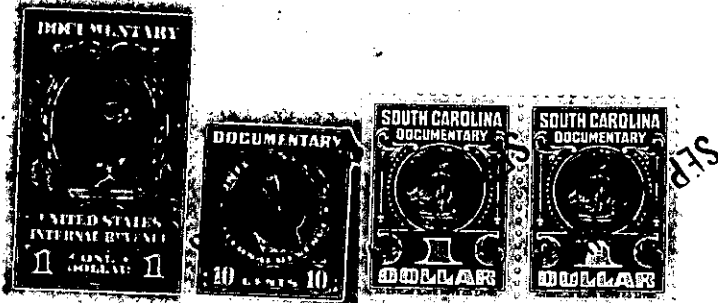

all that piece, parcel or lot of land in Fairview Township, Greenville
County, State of South Carolina and in the town of Fountain Inn on the east
side of Thackston Street, being known and designated as Lot
No. 7 on a plat made by W. J. Riddle, Surveyor, on March 29,
1947 - Said plat being of record in the R. M. C. Office for
Greenville County, S. C., in Plat Book B, at page 131; said
lot fronting on Thackston Street seventy (70) feet and running
back a distance of two hundred twenty (220) feet from the center
of said street to other property of the grantors and being seventy
(70) feet wide in the rear, bounded by Thackston Street, Lots
Nos. 6 and 8 of said survey and other lands of the grantors.
The within described premises being a portion of the land con-
veyed to W. Shell Thackston and W. T. Thackston by deed of
Sallie Kate Woods on the 30th day of December 1919, said deed
being of record in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County,
S. C., in Deed Book 88, at page 594.
