



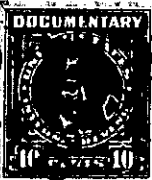

All that certain parcel, and tract of land, situate, lying and being in South Carolina, Greenville County, Saluda Township, and on the South side of all that piece, parcel or lot of land in South Carolina Township, Saluda Township, County, State of South Carolina Greenville

National Highway 25, and having the following metes and bounds, to wit:

BEGINNING at a stake on the North side of the said highway, in the center of an intersecting road, northeast of the barn and the corner of lot No. 17, and runs thence N. 65-15 W. up the mountain, and with the line of Lot No. 17, 1100 ft. to a stake, joint corners of lots Nos. 14, 12, 11, and 17; thence N. 53 E 1320 ft. to a stake on the right of way of said National Highway 25; thence in a south easterly direction 1300 ft. to the point and place of the beginning, and designated as lot No. 14 on a plat prepared by Justice and Miller, Surveyors, Hendersonville, North Carolina, dated June 1936, and to be recorded in Book J at page 210, and containing according to said plat seventeen and forty-one hundredths (17.41) acres, be the same more or less, which said plat is hereby referred to as a basis of this description.
