All that piece, parcel or lot of land in Greenville Township, Greenville County, State

of South Carolina, on the North side of the Easley Bridge Road, School District
8-F, and being known and designated as Lot No. 6 of the property of R.J.
Sentell, as shown on plat thereof recorded in the R. M. C. office for
Greenville County in Plat Book I, at page 75, and having the following
metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin in the right-of-way line on the North side of
the Easley Bridge Road at the corner of Lot No. 5, and running thence
