do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said...G. P. Brissey, his heirs and assigns,
forever:

All my undivided one-half interest in and to all that certain
piece, parcel or lot of land with the buildings and improvements
thereon situate, lying and being on the South side of East Broad
Street in the City of Greenville, County of Greenville, State of
South Carolina, being formerly known as the residence place of
R. W. Goddard, deceased, and having the following metes and bounds,
to-wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the South side of East Broad Street
at corner of lot now or formerly of J. R. Jenkinson and running
thence with the South side of East Broad Street, N. 70- $\frac{1}{2}$ W. 60
feet to an iron pin at corner of lot formerly of Ella D. Barr;
thence with said Barr lot, S. 19- $\frac{3}{4}$ W. 158 $\frac{1}{2}$ feet to a stake on
the North side of Pearl Alley; thence with the North side of Pearl
Alley, S. 69- $\frac{3}{4}$ E. 60 feet to corner of said Jenkinson lot; thence
