All of my undivided one-half interest in and to all that piece, parcel or lot of land in Greenville Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, being a portion of Last Park, an addition to Boyce's Lawn, being known and designated as Lot No. 36, Block "L" according to a plat recorded in Plat Book A, page 303, R. M. C. Office for Greenville County and more particularly described as follows:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the North side of E. Washington Road, 100 feet from the Northwest intersection of Washington Road and Abaugh Avenue, joint corners of Lots Nos. 35 and 36 and running thence with line of Lot No. 35, N. 17-30 W. 167 feet to an iron pin on an alley; thence with line of said alley, S. 72-30 W. 50 feet to an iron pin; thence S. 17-30 E. 167 feet to an iron pin on North side of E.
