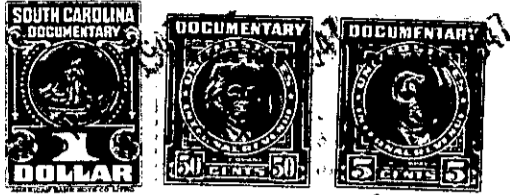

all that piece, parcel or lot of land in Chick Springs Township, Greenville

County, State of South Carolina, near Taylors, lying on the east side of the  
Edwards Road, being bounded on the north by lot of Bessie Bennett,  
Lucile Thompson, on the south by other lands of myself and on  
the west by the said Edwards Road, and being the northern part  
of the same lot that was conveyed to me by deed from Iola J.  
Pickett et al March 29th 1946 and recorded in the office of  
the R. M. C. for Greenville County in Deed Book 290 at page  
396, and having the following courses and distances, to wit :-

Beginning on an iron pin on the east abnk of Edwards Road,

of the Edwards Road; thence with the east bank of the said road
