

to me in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents
by James Max Sykes and Velma Thomas Sykes.....
(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents
do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said James Max Sykes and Velma Thomas Sykes,
Their heirs and assigns:

all that piece, parcel or lot of land in Township:
County, State of South Carolina

All that certain lot of land situate, lying and being in Greenville County, South Carolina, on the east side of Maco Terrace, known and designated as lot No. 4 of property of Central Realty Corporation according to a plat of said property made by Pickell & Pickell, Engineers dated March 13, 1946, recorded in the R. M.C. Office for said Greenville County in Plat Book P, at page 7, and having according to the said plat the following metes and bounds, to wit:

..... at a point on the east side of said Maco Terrace, joint corner of lots Nos. 3 and 4, which said corner is 200 feet from the corner of Maco Terrace and Ackley Road, and running the same with the east side of Maco Terrace, S. 36-07 E. 60 feet to a point, joint corner of lots Nos. 4 and 5; thence with the joint line of lots Nos. 4 and 5, S. 71-00 E. 125 feet to a point, joint rear corner of said lot No. 4; thence N. 36-07 W. 60 feet to a point, joint rear corner of lots Nos. 3 and 4; thence with the joint line of said lots Nos. 3 and 4, S. 71-00 E. 125 feet to the beginning point, corner of Lots Nos. 3 and 4 on the east side of Maco Terrace.
