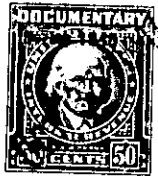
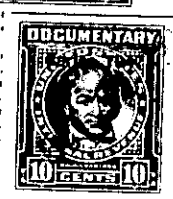

all that picce, parcel or lot of land in Greenville Township, Greenville  
County, State of South Carolina and being known and designated as Lot No. 22 in  
Block "E" of City View Property, according to plat of same recorded  
in Plat Book "E" at Page 124, and having the following metes and  
bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin, corner of Lots Nos. 21 and 22, run-  
ning thence N. 0-30 E. 165 feet to iron pin in line of Lot No. 29;  
thence N. 85 E. 50 feet to iron pin, corner of Lots Nos. 22 and 23;  
thence with line of Lot No. 23, S. 0-30 W. 161.6 feet to iron pin  
on Center Street; thence with Center Street S. 82 W. 50 feet to the  
beginning corner.

This being the same property conveyed to Burrows Blackwell and
