of South Carolina, located on the Southeasterly side of Cureton Street, and being a portion of Block "K", of a Subdivision known as Kanatenah, a plat of which is recorded in the R. M. C's Office for Greenville County, in Plat Book F, at Page 131, and having according to a recent survey thereof made by A. C. Crouch, Engineer, dated October 3, 1947, the following metes and bounds, courses and distances, to-wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the Southeasterly side of Cureton Street, which iron pin is 80 feet in an Easterly direction from the Southeastern intersection of Cureton and Mitchell Streets, at the corner of property now or formerly owned by Annie T. Lindsey; thence along the line of the Lindsey property S. 24-42 E. 178 feet to an iron pin in the line of property now or formerly owned by Lawton; thence along the line of the Lawton property N. 64-40 E. 65 feet to an iron pin in the line of the Thomas A. Prince lot; thence along the line of the Prince lot, N. 24-42 W. 178 feet to an iron pin in the line of Cureton Street; thence along the Southeasterly side of Cureton Street S. 64-40 W. 65 feet to the point of beginning.
