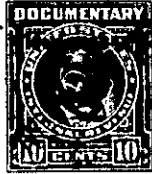

(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents
do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said..William R. Stack, his heirs and assigns,
forever:

All that parcel, piece or lot of land with the buildings and
improvements thereon, situate, lying and being on the Southwest
side of Bates Avenue, near the City of Greenville, in the County of
Greenville, State of South Carolina, being shown as Lot 16 on Plat
of Skyland Park, made by R. E. Dalton, Engineer, March 1941, recorded
in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County, S. C. in Plat Book "L",
Page 41, and having, according to said Plat, the following metes and
bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the Southwest side of Bates Avenue,
at joint front corner of Lots 16 and 17, said pin being 262.6 feet
in a Northwesterly direction from the point where the Southwest side
of Bates Avenue intersects with the Northwest side of Webster Road
and running thence along line of Lot 17, S. 44-37 W. 164.5 feet to an
iron pin; thence N. 50-27 W. 64 feet to an iron pin; thence with the
line of Lot 15, N. 49-12 E. 171.7 feet to an iron pin on the South-
west side of Bates Avenue; thence along the Southwest side of Bates
Avenue, S. 44-13 E. 50 feet to the beginning corner.

This is the same property conveyed to us by deed of R. E. Hughes,
dated August 16, 1941, recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville
County, S. C. in Deed Book 240, Page 103.

The Grantee is to pay 1947 taxes.
