County, State of South Carolina, lying on the north side of the Brushy Creek
Road and south from the Southern Railway right of way, being all
of Lot No. 49 on plat of property made for Mrs. Grace W. Schilletter
by H. L. Dunahoo, Surveyor, dated September 29, 1947, to be herewith
recorded, having the following courses and distances, to-wit:

BEGINNING at a stake on the north side of the Brushy Creek Road,
being the joint corner of Lots 49 and 50, and runs thence with the
common line of Lots 49 and 50, N. 15.23 W. 213 feet to a stake on
the south side of a new 20 foot street; thence with the south side
of said street S. 73.38 W. 50 feet to a stake, common corner Lots
