AND it does hereby bind itself and its successors and assigns to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said premises unto the said The Western Union Telegraph Company, a Corporation, its successors and assigns against itself and its successors and assigns and against every person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof.

AND it does hereby grant and convey unto the said The Western Union Telegraph Company, a Corporation, its successors, assigns, lessees and agents, a perpetual right-of-way and easement thirty (30) feet in width over and across the adjoining property owned by the grantor herein, from the boundary of the pro perty. herein conveyed and running in an easterly direction to the public road on the northeast side of Paris Mountain, to be used by The Western Union Telegraph Company, a Corporation, its successors and assigns, designees, lessees or agents as a means of egress and ingress to the property herein conveyed with the right in the said The Western Union Telegraph Company, a Corporation, its successors and assigns, designees, lessees or agents, to construct, reconstruct, operate, repair, relocate, and maintain poles, wires, cables, crossarms, conduits, pipe lines, guys, guy stubs, anchors and other fixtures and appurtenances as The Western Union Telegraph Company, a Corporation, its successors and assigns, designees, lessees or agents, may from time to time desire or require upon, over and/ or under said perpetual right-of-way and easement for sewers, electric lights, power, telephone, telegraph, and gas or for such other use as may be desired or required.
