WHEREAS, B. C. Clark and J. B. Knight

on or about the 4th day of August in the year of
our Lord nineteen hundred and forty-seven exhibited their
complaint in the Court of Common Pleas, for the County aforesaid, against

demanding relief as to the real estate described in the complaint: and the cause being at issue, came on to
be heard on the 16th day of October 1947,
and such proceedings were had therein as resulted in a decree of the said Court, whereby it was adjudged
and decreed that the said real estate hereinafter mentioned and described, be conveyed by E. INMAN,
Master in and for the County aforesaid, to B. C. Clark and J. B. Knight
for the purposes mentioned in the said decree, as by reference thereto on file in said Court, will appear:

NOW, Therefore, Know all Men by these Presents, that I, E. INMAN, Master, in and for the County
of Greenville aforesaid, by virtue of the aforesaid decree,

HAVE GRANTED, conveyed and released, and by these presents, DO GRANT, convey and release
unto the said B. C. Clark and J. B. Knight

"All that piece, parcel or lot of land in Greenville Township,
Greenville County, State of South Carolina, situate, lying and being
in Ward 2 of the City of Greenville, S. C., on the South side of Manly
Alley and being more particularly described as follows:

BEGINNING at a stake on the South side of said alley at the rear
corner of Lot of H. S. Latimer approximately 100 ft. in a westerly di-
rection from Glover St. and running thence in a westerly direction with
Manly Alley 93.8 ft. more or less to a stake on corner of Lot of Rebec-
ca F. Bailey, thence in a southerly direction with her line and with
the line of lot of Henry Campbell 105 ft. to a stake; thence in an
easterly direction in a line parallel with line of Manly Alley 95 ft.
more or less to a stake on a line of lot of H. B. Tindall; thence in
a northerly direction with the line of that lot and the line of H. S.
Latimer lot 105 ft. to a stake on the South side of Manly Alley the
beginning corner and being the northern half of the lot of land convey-
ed to E. L. Little by Rosa B. Irvine by her deed dated January 10, 1920,
