

Said one-half of Lot No. 57 is more particularly desoribed as follows:

BEGINNING 100 feet from the southern right angle of Love Drive at a point midway on the line of Lot no. 57 and running S. 25-41 E. 100 feet along the eastern side of Love Drive to the rear boundary of Lot No. 32; thence along the joint lines of Lots Nos. 32 and 57, N. 64 E. 90 feet to corner; thence along the joint lines of Lots Nos. 57 and 58, N. 25-41 W. 100 feet to a point midway on the said joint line; thence S. 64 W. 90 feet to the beginning corner.
