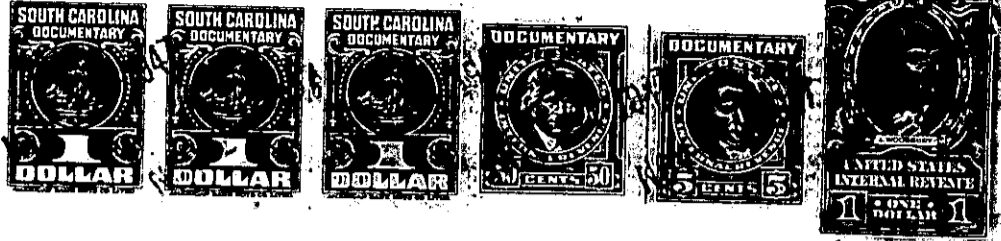

do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said **Harley M. Watson, his heirs and assigns**
forever:-

all that piece, parcel or lot of land in **Butler** Township, **Greenville**
County, State of South Carolina, on the western side of the public road leading
into or through the lands of J. R. Green and/or the U. S. Government,
and near Enoree River, and designated as lot #9 on plat of the E. M.
Dill property, prepared by H. S. Brockman, Surveyor, November 20th,
1945, and having the following courses and distances, to-wit:-
Beginning at the joint corner of lots 9 and 10 in the center of said
