All that piece, parcel or lot of land in Greenville Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, in the First Ward of the City of Greenville, and having the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at a stake on the Northeast corner of the intersection of Hampton Avenue and Briggs Avenue, and running thence along said Hampton Avenue, S. 32 E. 65½ feet to the corner of a 50-foot lot conveyed to J. S. Elmore by E. D. Crook; thence along line of said Elmore lot, N. 58 E. 115 feet to a stake on the line of lot owned by Charles E. Gilreath; thence along line of last mentioned lot, N. 32 W. 65½ feet to a stake on Briggs Avenue; thence along Briggs Avenue, S. 58 W. 115 feet to the beginning corner.

Said premises being the same conveyed to Ola B. Gilreath and E. Gertrude Gaines by deed dated November 26, 1928, recorded in Book of Deeds 127 at Page 252.
