all that piece, parcel or lot of land in Chick Springs Township, Greenville
County, State of South Carolina, lying about one and one-half miles southwest
from the City of Greer on the south side of the right of way of
the Southern Railway, being all of Lots Nos. 42 and 43, lying near
the southern railway and southwest therefrom and on the south side
of a new street that leads from the Brushy Creek Road, according to
plat of said property made for Mrs. Grace W. Schilletter by H. L.
Dunahoo, Surveyor, dated September 29, 1947, said plat to be herewith
recorded, and having the following courses and distances:

BEGINNING at a stake on the east side of said street, joint corner
