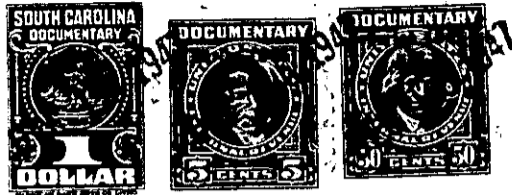

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That I, G. D. Collier,

in the State aforesaid, in consideration of the sum of One Hundred Fifty and no/100 .....  
..... Dollars  
to me..... in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents  
by Theron E. Barton and W. Morris Barton.....  
(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents  
do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Theron E. Barton and W. Morris Barton,  
and their Heirs and Assigns forever,

all that piece, parcel or lot of land in Chick Springs Township, Greenville  
County, State of South Carolina, lying about one mile east from the Town of  
Taylors, and lying between the new U. S. Super Highway No. 29 and  
the P&N Railway, being all of Lots 29, 30 and 31 as shown by plat  
of property made for G. D. Collier by H. L. Dunahoo, Surveyor, dated  
October 27, 1947, to be hereafter recorded, and having the following  
courses and distances, to-wit:

BEGINNING on a stake at the intersection of the street that leads  
from the P&N Railway to the new Super Highway with another street that  
leads westward therefrom, and runs thence along the northern edge of  
street S. 79 W. 217.5 feet to a stake, joint corner of Lots 31 and  
32; thence about N. 12.55 W. 150 feet to a stake, joint corner of  
Lots 28, 29, 25 and 32; thence with the common line of Lots 28 and  
29 N. 78.30 E. 173 feet to a stake on the west edge of street; thence  
with the west edge of street in a southeasterly direction 157.5 feet  
to the beginning corner.
