



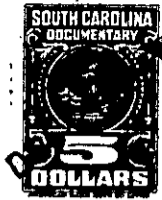

(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents  
do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said *William Lewis and Martha B. Ross*

all that piece, parcel or lot of land in *Chick Springs* Township, *Greenville*

County, State of South Carolina, and adjoining lands of *C. P. Phillips*  
estate on the east and other lands of the grantor on  
the south and west, and lands of *C. P. Phillips* Estate  
on the north, and having the following metes and  
bounds: -

Beginning at a post Oak on *C. P. Phillips* Estate  
line, thence with said line *N. 9 1/2 E. 330* feet to a  
stone on a public road, thence along and across  
said road *S. 79 1/2 E. 132* feet to iron pin in east  
edge of road, thence *S. 12 1/4 W. 330* feet to a stone  
in open field, thence *N. 79 1/2 W. 115* feet to beginning
