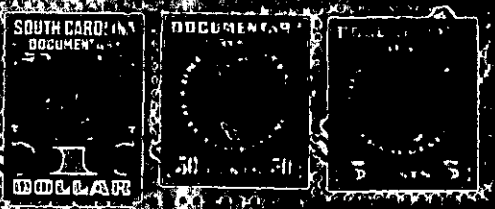

Know All Men by These Presents, That I, Louise Bentley, of Greenville County

in the State aforesaid, in consideration of the sum of One Hundred Twenty Five Dollars (\$125.00) to me paid by Marcelle Heath Sexton, of Greenville County in the State aforesaid,

have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Marcelle Heath Sexton, her heirs and assigns, all that piece, parcel or lot of land in Greenville Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, having the following courses and distances:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on Riverside Road, running thence N. 42 E. 150 feet; thence S. 47 1/2 E. 67 feet to an iron pin; thence S 43 W. 150 feet to an iron pin on Riverside Road; thence with Riverside Road 70 feet to the beginning corner, being lot No. 5 of a subdivision known as Verner Hill.

The above described land is the same conveyed to me by James Dean Wilson on the 16th day of August, 1947, deed recorded in the office of the Register of Mesne Conveyance for Greenville County in Deed Book 318 at page 124.
