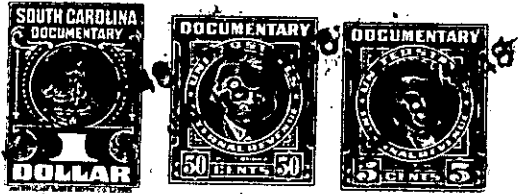

do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Robert L. Lee Harris and Sadie W. Harris, their heirs, and assigns

all that piece, parcel or lot of land in Grove Township, Greenville  
County, State of South Carolina and more fully described as follows:

Beginning at an iron pin in the road near B. B. Young's residence and at corner of lands of E. B. Martin, Jr. and running thence with Martin's line S. 1-45 W. 437 feet to a point in another road; thence continuing with this last mentioned road S 11 W. 200 feet to an iron pin; thence leaving said road and running N. 72 W. 250 feet to an iron pin; thence N. 9-45 E. 566 feet to a point in the road; thence along the road S. 89 E. 200 feet to the beginning point and containing 3.28 acres of land more or less and being a part of the same land conveyed to me by deed of Ancrum Fuller, dated February 22, 1918 and recorded in the R.
