in the state aforesaid, in consideration of the sum of Six Hundred (\$600.00) dollars, to US in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by J. T. Daniel.....

(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said .. J. T. Daniel...

All that piece, parcel or lot of land in Dunklin Township, Greenville County, and State of South Carolina.

All those two tracts of land situate, lying and being on the North side of Saluda River, and the West Side of Mountain Creek containing about Twenty - nine and 75/100 acres, more or less, and are joining lands now or formerly owned by E. L. Ridgeway, Mrs. Harriett and Emma Ridgeway, W.H. Ridgeway, J.L. French, and George H. Ridgeway. This being the same land conveyed to our Mother, Mrs. Emma S. Reaves by J.L. Whitt, by Deed dated November 7th, 1914, and recorded in Deed Book 51, at page 69, of the records of Greenville County.

These tracts are known as Nos. 5 and 10, in the Subdivision of the real estate of John J. Ridgeway, deceased, and are shown by Plat made by J.H. Gaines, Surveyor, bearing date of October, 1901.

The said Mrs. Emma S. Reaves, our mother, died intestate, leaving the grantors herein as her only heirs and distributees.
