all that piece, parcel or lot of land in Chick Springs Township, Greenville

County, State of South Carolina, about two miles southwest from Greer, near Pleasant Grove Baptist Church, lying on the western side of the Greer-Gibbs Shoals Road, being a part of the same land that was conveyed to me by deed from Mary Alice Burnett et al November 25th 1931 and recorded in the office of the R. M. C. for Greenville County in Deed Book 154 at page 443, and being bounded on the north-west and northeast by other lands of myself, on the east by the said road and lands of Brookshire and on the southwest by lands of Burnett, and having the following courses and distances, to wit :-
