HAVE GRANTED, conveyed and released, and by these presents, DO GRANT, convey and release
unto the said Drive-In Theatres of South Carolina, Inc.

All the right, title and interest of the minor defendant, Henry
Tindal, the same being an undivided two-ninths interest, in and to the
following described real estate:

"All that piece, parcel or lot of land in Paris Mountain Town-
ship, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, on the New Buncombe
Highway containing 9.988 acres, and having, according to a plat made by
Pickell & Pickell, Engineers, in January, 1948, and to be recorded, the
