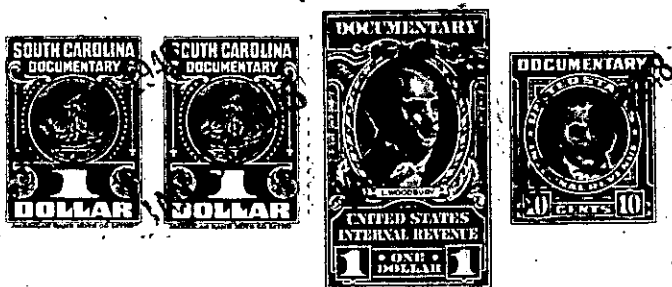

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That I, Samuel L. Gault

in the State aforesaid, in consideration of the sum of Five Hundred Seventy Five and No/100 Dollars

to me in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by Belton Chesney

(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Belton Chesney, his heirs and assigns, forever:

all that piece, parcel or lot of land in Fairview Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina and in the town of Fountain Inn on the east side of Hellams Street and described according to a plat made by W. M. Nash, Registered Engineer and Surveyor, on November 21, 1944, as follows: Known and designated as Lot No. 7 of the Kellett Brothers and John D. Holler property as shown by the above mentioned plat and beginning on an iron pin on said Hellams Street, joint front corner with lot No. 6 of said Survey, running thence along line of Lot No. 6 S. 46 E. 207.5 feet to an iron pin; thence N. 17 1/4 E. 91.5 feet to an iron pin back joint corner with lot No. 8 of said survey; thence with line of Lot No. 8 N. 46 W. 168 feet to an iron pin on Hellams Street, joint front corner with No. 8 of said Survey; thence along Hellams Steet S. 44 W. 85 feet to an iron pin, the point of beginning. Bounded by Hellams Street, Lots No. 6 & 8 of said Survey and Kellett Land, and containing thirty-six one-hundredths (.36) of one acre, more or less.
