FIRST: That their names and residences are as above given.

SECOND: That the name of the proposed corporation is

CARR BUILDERS SUPFLIES

THIRD: That the principal place of business is

GREENVILLE, S.C.

FOURTH: That the general nature of the business which it is proposed to do is to operate a general wholesale and retail lumber business including the cutting, processing and manufacturing of lumber and lumber products and any other building material operating saw mills, and doing a general construction business; to buy, sell, improve, manage, lease, mortgage or otherwise dispose of or deal in real estate; to buy, sell and deal in stocks, bonds, notes, mortgages or other securities and to do any and all other things incidental to, growing out of or connected with the aforesaid business.
