BEGINNING at a line of lot on Lois Street, now or  
formerly belonging to J. N. Clements, and running along  
the north side of Lois Street in an easterly direction  
33 feet to Hunt Street; thence along Hunt Street in a  
northerly direction 108 feet to a pin; thence in a  
westerly direction 58 feet to a pin; thence in a south-
