on Reedy River, about nine miles above the City of Greenville, near
the White Horse Road, adjoining Lots No. 5 and 7 and having the follow-
ing metes and bounds:

Beginning at a stake on Reedy River, corner of Lot No. 3 and thence
N. 22¹/₂ W. 3.18 to stake; thence S. 79¹/₂ W. 8.35 to stone; thence N. 42¹/₂
W. 2.50 to stone; thence S. 70¹/₂ W. 7.60 to pine stump; thence N. 25¹/₂
E. 40.74 to stone on new road; thence down said road S. 51 E. 6.30 to
angle in road; thence S. 34 E. 11.35 to angle in road; thence S. 25 E.
