(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents
do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said S. D. Pridmore, his heirs and assigns
forever.

All that piece, parcel or lot of land in Greenville Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, being on the White Horse road, about three miles from Greenville Court-house, known as part-of-Tracts Nos. 25 and 26 on the revised plat of the Yown property, and according a plat made by Dalton and Neaves, Jan. 1948. has the following courses and distance.

BEGINNING at a point at the joint corner of Tract No. 26 and 25 on the White Horse Road. thence running along the lines of said lots, S. 62-09 W. 211.6 feet to the line of Tract No 24; thence running along the line of Tract No. 24 S. 26-30 E. 100 feet; thence N 62-09 E. 204.2 feet to a point on the White Horse Road; thence N. 22-16 W. a-long the White Horse Road to the beginning corner 100.2 feet.

It is the intent of this deed to convey to S. D. Pridmore, the grantee herein, all of that property which he conveyed to me by deed dated January 15, 1948, recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County, S. C., in Deed Book 334, at page 113.
