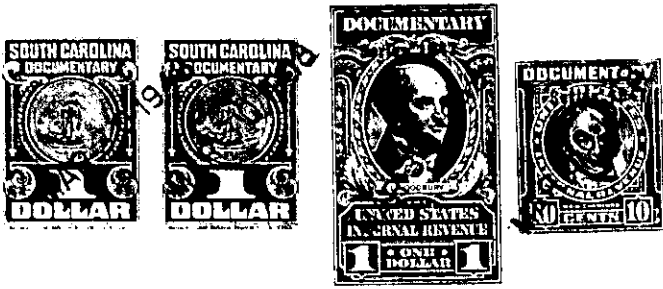

do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said J. Marvin Johnson his Heirs and
Assigns forever:

all that piece, parcel or lot of land in Fairview Township, Greenville
County, State of South Carolina and in the town of Fountain Inn on the west
side of Shaw or Sixth Street with the following metes and bounds,
to-wit: Beginning at an iron pin in edge of Butler Avenue, northern
side, and running thence along Shaw or Sixth Street in a northeasterly
direction 150 feet to a point; thence in a northwesterly direction
202 feet to a point; thence in a south or southwesterly direction
150 feet to a point in the edge of said Butler Avenue; thence with
said Avenue 202 feet to the point of beginning, and bounded by Shaw
or Sixth Street, Butler Avenue and lands of Woodside Cotton Mill,
